Investing in Equality (IiE) is a bespoke leadership development programme for Black and minority ethnic (BME) educators who aspire to leadership roles and is part of the Children's Workforce Development strategy in the South West and the Diversifying School Leadership strategy of the National College for Leadership of Schools and Children's Services.

Programme aims

- To identify potential black and minority ethnic school leaders in Bristol and the South West including teachers who aspire to new leadership positions.
- To provide culturally sensitive leadership coaching of the highest calibre drawing on best practice inside and outside of education.
- To increase the number of Black and minority ethnic leaders in schools in Bristol and the South West.

Programme Structure

There are 10 modules of three hours duration (5pm -8pm) to be held at the University of West of England (UWE) generally on the last Thursday of every month starting on **25th November 2010**, and there will be a major **'Launch Conference'** on **4 November 2010** at Engineers House, Bristol, with keynote speakers and workshops.

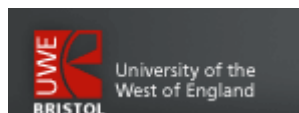
