This conference follows on from the first ever, and highly successful, BME educators' day held in September 2008. Open to BME educators in all schools and settings – including leaders, teachers, governors and learning support staff – the focus will again be on **you and your needs** in playing your part in raising achievement in Bristol schools. Headteachers and managers are welcome to attend with their BME staff.

The day will be led by the Ethnic Minority Achievement Team with a range of inspirational invited speakers. We are delighted that Dr Rosemary Campbell-Stephens from the London Centre for Leadership and Learning and NCSL has already agreed to take part again. It is expected that other contributors will include Sir William Atkinson, the headteacher who 'turned around' Phoenix High School in London, Hugh Howe, 'super head' at Earl Marshall School in Sheffield, Paulette Wisdom from Visions of Esteem, Andrew Mohammed (aka 'The Investigator'), and Paul Obinna, freelance consultant and originator of 'Timeline'. The detailed programme will be sent to schools and colleagues nearer the time.

Notes

The conference is centrally funded and is **free** for BME educators in Bristol LA-maintained schools and settings to attend. In addition we are offering:

- A contribution of £100 per school towards cover costs for each of the first 30 school-based BME teachers who apply;
- A contribution of £50 per school towards cover costs for each of the first 30 school-based BME learning support staff who apply.

Applications must be received by **Friday 25 September 2009** to be eligible for the contribution.

Non-Bristol LA schools including academies are welcome to attend at a cost of £50 per place.
